Finland | Drama, Romance | 107 mins

Joint winner of the Grand Prix at Cannes, *Compartment No. 6* unfolds as an unconventional love story when two strangers share a Russian train journey through the Arctic Circle. Laura and Vadim experience rough terrain in more ways than one as the train moves toward Murmansk and an unexpected bond is formed between these two vastly different people.

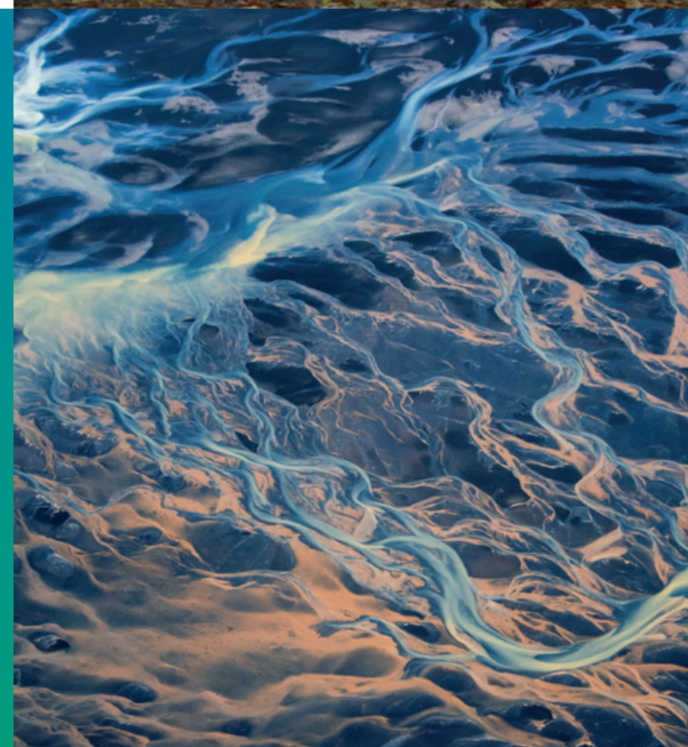


PREPARATIONS TO BE TOGETHER FOR AN UNKNOWN PERIOD OF TIME M
