
## ABOUT KOOLBARDI WER WARDONG

#### Koolbardi wer Wardong is based on a traditional Noongar story.


## KOOLBARDI THE MAGPIE

### WARDONG THE CROW






#### Wardong the Crow is quiet and considers himself more intelligent than Koolbardi.

### MEET THE CHARACTERS






Apart from Koolbardi the Magpie and Wardong the Crow, there are several other characters who you will meet...




The Barna Warangka is the animal chorus performed by local South-West children supported by Lotterywest.






