Skip the Box Office queue, squash the stress, secure your seat and spend your well-earned downtime having a drink and something to eat!



France | Comedy | French with English subtitles | 99 mins

To escape from police after a chaotic jewel heist a notorious criminal and his adult son are mistakenly ushered onto a bus bound for a summer camp for young adults with disabilities. The highest grossing French film for a decade, this deeply moving comedy from comedian Artus is part whacky misadventure, part unexpected journey of growth.




Cutting Through Rocks [CTC]

Iran | Documentary | Azeri Turkish, Farsi with English subtitles | 95 mins

This Sundance Grand Jury Prize winner follows Sara, a fearless, motorbikeriding feminist and the first woman elected to public office in her remote Iranian community after a landslide victory. As she challenges entrenched patriarchal traditions and amplifies the voices of young women, resistance intensifies, pushing Sara to confront her identity and the true cost of her trailblazing path.

North Macedonia | Drama, Comedy Macedonian, Turkish with English subtitles | 99 mins

A coming-of-age tale, told anew, Ahmet is a 15-year-old boy on the cusp of his first love, betrothed to another. He dreams of DJ stardom as he drops fist-pumping techno tracks from a tractor, all to the backdrop of stunning North Macedonian landscapes, but must also navigate familial expectations and the rules of his close-knit, traditional community.



When Molly meets an old fiddle player with 'magic in his hands' she is convinced that if he can teach her to play the fiddle like her Dad and she can win the All-Ireland Fiddle Competition it will wake her dad from a coma.

I SWEAR follows John Davidson's remarkable journey from troubled teen to a powerful voice for change. Growing up with Tourette's Syndrome in 1980s Britain, when the condition was unrecognised and misunderstood, John transforms isolation and misunderstanding into courage, using his unfiltered voice to challenge stigma and inspire a movement.






